Transportation Guidelines

Bus Transportation Overview

Free transportation services are provided by your child's School District of Residence based on the address on file that matches your Proof of Residency documentation. Per district policy, eligibility for transportation services may be limited to a specific radius surrounding the location of the school. Requests for transportation must be received by July 1 and services will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis, capacity permitting. Requests for transportation received after July 1st cannot be guaranteed and may not be considered for routing until October.

Cleveland Municipal School District (CMSD)

If your child resides within the Cleveland Municipal School District (CMSD), transportation eligibility is based on the distance from your child's home residence to the school.

- K-6 Grade students must live 1-5 miles from campus to receive yellow bus service.
- 7-8 Grade students must live 1 mile or greater from campus to receive RTA passes.
- K-8 Grade students who live less than 1 mile from campus are considered as residing within the walk zone and are not eligible to receive CMSD transportation services.
- K-8 Grade students with a home residence calculated by CMSD as 30+ minutes from campus are ineligible for yellow bus service and payment options (such as RTA).

How to Apply for CMSD Yellow Bus & RTA Reimbursement Services:

- Register or re-enroll your student with the school office. At time of registration, complete a Request for Transportation form (RFT). The address on the form must match the address on file with the school and be verified by a Proof of Residence (POR) document.
- The school office will submit your request to Community Bus Services, CMSD's vendor, for
 processing. For yellow bus service, Community Bus will verify residence before routing the student, and
 the student will receive a letter to the home address indicating the service start date. For RTA Payment
 services, CMSD will verify residence. Paper passes will be delivered to the campus and the school office
 will distribute to the student.

Maple Heights City School District

If your child resides within the Maple Heights City School District, free transportation services may be provided based on the address on file that matches your Proof of Residency documentation. Per district policy, eligibility for transportation services may be limited to a specific radius surrounding the location of the school. Requests for transportation must be received by July 1 and services will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis, capacity permitting. Requests for transportation received after July 1st cannot be guaranteed and will not be considered for routing until October.

• The Maple Heights City School District may determine transportation eligibility services in the form of Yellow Bus, RTA passes, or Payment in Lieu of Transportation.

How to Apply for Maple Heights City Schools Transportation Services:

- Register or re-enroll your student with the school office. At time of registration, complete a Request for Transportation form (RFT). The address on the form must match the address on file with the school and be verified by a Proof of Residence (POR) document.
- The school office will submit your request to Maple Heights City Schools District for processing. Maple Heights City Schools will verify residence before routing the student, and the student will receive a letter to the home address indicating the service start date.

Garfield Heights City School District

If your child resides within the Garfield Heights City School District, free transportation services may be provided based on the address on file that matches your Proof of Residency documentation. Per district policy, eligibility for transportation services may be limited to a specific radius surrounding the location of the school. Requests for transportation must be received by July 1 and services will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis, capacity permitting. Requests for transportation received after July 1 st cannot be guaranteed and will not be considered for routing until October.

• The Garfield Heights City School District may determine transportation eligibility services in the form of Yellow Bus, RTA passes, or Payment in Lieu of Transportation.

How to Apply for Garfield Heights City Schools Transportation Services:

• Register or re-enroll your student with the school office. At time of registration, complete a Request for Transportation form (RFT). The address on the form must match the address on file with the school and be verified by a Proof of Residence (POR) document.

• The Warrensville Heights City School District may determine transportation eligibility services in the form of Yellow Bus, RTA passes, or Payment in Lieu of Transportation.

How to Apply for Warrensville Heights City Schools District Transportation Services:

- Warrensville Heights City Schools Transportation Department is responsible for transporting students. To apply, contact the school office manager to complete a Warrensville Transportation Application and submit three proof of residency documents to Warrensville Transportation Department.
- Warrensville Heights City Schools will verify residence before routing the student, and the student will receive a letter to the home address with routing information and start date.
